As a child, I spent many hours playing games and always expected to let someone else go. I went back and played them a few times as an adult and still find them funny, even if the graphics are outdated and acting is vain at times. But my favorite game in the series is undoubtedly Jedi Knight II: The Jedi from 1999. Have you ever wanted to

see Han Solo as a sword? This is the game for you. This first-person shooter follows Kyle Catternan, who is luke and klan's best parts, mixed into one man.
